WHY PARTICIPATE IN TESTING

- * Effective tool for monitoring a student's progress from year to year and measuring against nationwide standards
- * Provides information to help determine whether students are on track to be ready for success in college or career upon high school graduation

* School results are posted and reviewed by the public, state, charter authorizers, and parents. Poor results adversely impact the school.

* Schools are penalized when less than 95% of eligible students participate



BE TEST READY WITH EDULASTIC

To familiarize students with the types of question on the CAASPP, an Edulastic account has been created for each student. Once a week students log in to complete 3 to 6 preselected Math or Language Arts questions. They will receive immediate scores and can check their answers.
