

Elite Academic Academy COVID-19 Reopening Plan Fact Sheet

The Elite Academic Academy Charter Schools strategic school reopening plan will be based on guidance from the following organizations:

1. State of California
2. County Public Health Departments in schools' service areas
3. Center for Disease Control
4. California's Industry Guidance for Schools and School-Based Programs
5. CalOSHA
6. Local County Ordinances
7. Westlake Risk and Insurance Services

The safety, health and well-being of Elite Academic Academy Charter Schools' students and staff is our top priority. The strategic reopening plan is constructed to establish continuity for student learning during different stages of the schools' reopening. Our additional goal is to work to stop the spread of respiratory infectious diseases, including COVID-19, among staff, students and families.

Defining Terms:

* Nonessential work is a task or activity that can be completed virtually.

Essential Work: Essential work is defined as tasks or activities critical to the operations of the school that are vitally important and absolutely must be conducted or completed in person. These tasks cannot be completed remotely or virtually nor be placed on hold without having a significant impact on the school or its students.

Gathering: Any event or convening of a group of people that brings together more than one person in a single room or single indoor/outdoor space at the same time, such as:

- Learning Period Meetings, and materials delivery;
- SPED services, assessments and meetings;
- Student in-person events, school-sponsored events, field trips, non-parent proctored testing, Elite Academic offices staffing, and personnel meetings and events.

Social Distancing: Maintaining a six-foot separation from all persons except for household members, first responders, and medical providers or employees conducting temperature screenings.

COVID-19 Protect yourself and loved ones

- + WASH YOUR HANDS**

- + COVER A COUGH OR SNEEZE**

Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth, especially with unwashed hands.
- + KEEP YOUR DISTANCE**
Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

If you experience respiratory symptoms like a cough or fever, stay home.
- + GET HELP**
If you experience symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, shortness of breath), call your health care provider or local health department before seeking care.
