NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Regular Board of Education Meeting

December 2, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.

It is recommended the Board of Directors declare a public hearing for the purpose of reviewing the Educator Effectiveness Block Grant (EEBG). This is a program providing funds to county offices of education, school districts, charter schools, and state special schools to provide professional learning and to promote educator equity, quality, and effectiveness.

As a condition of receiving funds for educator effectiveness, LEAs shall develop and adopt a plan for expenditure of funds, which requires the plan to be explained in a public meeting of the governing board of the school district, county board of education, or governing body of the charter school before its adoption in a subsequent meeting. These expenditures may take place over fiscal years 2021–22, 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, and 2025–26. LEAs may use these allocated funds to provide professional learning for teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals who work with students, and classified staff that interact with students in order to promote educator equity, quality, and effectiveness.

This public hearing is to allow for public comment and recommendations regarding the specific actions and expenditures proposed to be included in the Educator Effectiveness Block Grant (EEBG) Application 2021-22, at which time the Board will hear any relevant public comment. The proposed Educator Effectiveness Block Grant (EEBG) Application is on file and available for public review at the Elite Academic Academy, Temecula Business Offices.

After hearing comments from the public, the Board President will give notice that a vote on this item is scheduled for a December 2021 Special Board meeting.
