

What is Level Up Virtual Academy Learning Period?



Level Up Virtual Academy is an **annual program** that runs during the first learning period (5 weeks) of our year-round calendar. It is designed for high school students to enroll in **ten credits of A-G**, **NCAA-approved coursework** they did not successfully complete during the traditional school year or to get ahead of schedule for the next school year.

Incoming 9th graders are welcome to join us to get a headstart on their high school career, as are high school students who want to extend their learning into the summer, earn certifications through our high-interest **Career Technical Education (CTE) courses**, or explore an area of passion.

- Access to academic and emotional counseling resources as needed
